

## Scenario 5

The story starts the same as [Scenario 4](#) [1], but instead of your leader looking and rushing ahead, your wheel dogs start to turn around and look behind you. Soon all your dogs are straining to get a look at something behind you. You focus your headlamp on the trail behind and on a straight stretch, another team comes into view, going like crazy, with the sled swinging all over the trail behind them. Nobody is driving that team!

- What do you do?
- What could have happened to the musher?
- Can you remember how far behind you the next two mushers were scheduled to leave the last checkpoint? How does that help you?
- What could the effects be on the dogs that have run out-of-control?
